Alerts

Quick Reference — We have 14 Alert types as follows. (All percentage values are for illustrative purposes)

1.1) When Pat is Buying an Initial Position, the post will appear like this:

I am Bbuying XYZ [50% Initial Position]



1.2) When Pat is Buying an Add-on to an Existing Position, the post will appear like this:

I am Bbuying XYZ [30% Add-on]



An Add-on is a percentage of the originally purchased shares.

1.3) When Pat is Pyramiding (increasing position size), the post will appear like this:

I am Bbuying XYZ [20% Pyramid]



Pyramiding differs from an Add-on in that the percentage purchased is a percent of an entire position.

2.1) When Pat is placing a Buy Stop order, the post will appear like this:

I am Bbuying XYZ using Buy Stop at \$73 [50% Initial Position]



2.2) When Pat is placing a Buy Stop **Add-on** order, the post will appear like this:

I am Bbuying XYZ using Buy Stop at \$77 [30% Add-on]



2.3) When Pat is Pyramiding (increasing a position) by use of a Buy Stop, the post will appear like this:

I am Bbuying XYZ using Buy Stop at \$175.50 [30% Pyramid]



2.4) When a Buy Stop triggers, Pat will send out a Filled alert that will appear like this:

Buy Stop on XYZ Filled at \$52.90



3.1) When Pat is Selling all or part of a holding (note the percentage*), the post will appear like this:

I am Sselling XYZ [50% of holdings]



^{*}The amount sold is always a percentage of the **current holding**, <u>not of the initial position</u>. If the holding is sold flat, the percentage sold will state 100%.

3.2) When Pat is placing a Sell Stop order, the post will appear like this:

I am Sselling XYZ using Sell Stop at \$36.48 [50% of holdings]



The amount sold is always a percentage of the **current holding**, <u>not of the initial position</u>. If the holding is sold flat, the percentage sold will state 100%.

3.3) When a Sell Stop triggers, Pat will send out a Filled alert that will appear like this:

Sell Stop on XYZ Filled at \$228



4.1) When Pat posts a Buy Add-on alert for a watched stock, the post will appear like this:

If you own XYZ could be Bbuying [30% Add-on to the position]



Pat will watch Key List stock positions for members even if he is not in the trade. When you see a Blue alert like this, it indicates that Pat is not in the trade, but he has issued an alert for those who hold a position.

4.2) When Pat posts a Sell alert for a watched stock, the post will appear like this:

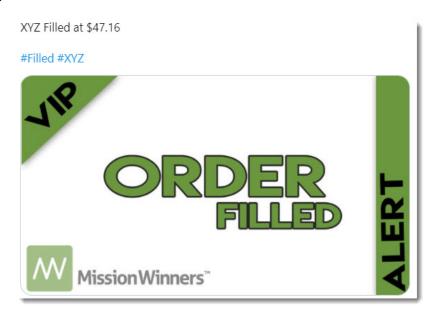
If you own XYZ could be Sselling [20% of the position]



Pat will watch Key List stock positions for members even if he is not in the trade. When you see a Blue alert like this, it indicates that Pat is not in the trade, but he has issued an alert for those who hold a position.

5.1) After a Buy order is routed, Pat will follow-up with his Filled price; the post will appear like this:

XYZ Filled at \$47.16



5.2) Following the issuance of a Sell alert, Pat will follow-up with a Filled alert that will appear like this:

XYZ Filled at \$165.80
